I am looking for other steampunk artists interested in helping me design 3d models to print on my 3d printer. steampunk props like Rayguns, blunderbuss, wrist bands, bracers, gears, goggles, mechanical hands and arms, masks and Steampunk VR goggles, ornaments for decorating items and Garb. etc. i have a 3d printer that can print 8x8x8 volume. larger items can be made in segments and assembled after printing. i have Over 25 spools of filament in 20+ colors.

i want to design and build steampunk Zeppelins, airships and other mechanical devices. some items can be printed in plastic then use that to make molds to cast in metal or ceramic, etc.
