Just so. I occasionally top-post when a previous post may be needed for reference but my own contribution is essentially stand-alone and not in the nature of conversation. This appears to be common in business email where I find it workable and correct -- at worst a "minor burden".

Most Usenet posts are more or less in the nature of conversation so top-posting is a stumbling block as is massive quoting -- failure to trim -- when responding to some small element of a previous post.
