(I had just learned about exploding PRAM batteries the other day but had never seen it.) If it's even repairable, it would require way more skill and patience than I have.

As bad as it is, I'd hate to see it end up at the electronics recycler. If anyone wants to take on this monumental task, it's available for the cost of shipping plus \$10 for shipping supplies.
